Other Requirements:

Permission for this movement is hereby granted subject to compliance with provisions of the laws of the State of North Dakota and County of Richland and under the terms, conditions and restriction contained herein and on the reverse side of this permit, and subject to revocation upon non-compliance. Violation of attached policies will void the permit in its entirety

NOTICE

The hauling of loads that exceed the legal limits is a privilege granted where the property hauled cannot be stripped down. If the weight as allowed by the permit is in fact more than the weight of the property for which the permit is issued, no additional property can be loaded. The weight must be as little over the legal limits as stripping will allow.

Misrepresentation by the applicant or his agent makes this permit void. Violation of the following requirements voids this permit.

The use of the permit shall be construed as an agreement to the terms listed hereon.

Permit Requirements for All Oversize and Overweight Movements including Mobile Homes and Modular Units.

1. No travel on shoulders of road
2. No travel if the visibility is poor or the highway is slippery. No travel during any adverse road conditions.
3. Towing vehicle must have rear view mirrors that reflect a rear view of 200' of the driver.
4. The traffic side of all oversize vehicles shall be marked plainly with red flags so that the clearance width and vehicle's length are readily determined to drivers of other vehicles. Such flags shall be a minimum of 18" x 18".
5. Vehicles of excessive width while moving where it is difficult or hazardous for other vehicles to pass, shall be approved with flagpersons 700 to 1500' ahead and to the rear, and as many other flagpersons as required to direct traffic safely. Mover must allow traffic to pass each crossroad or wherever a hazard develops.
6. Vehicles are not to be parked on the traveled way under any circumstances.
7. No movement before sunrise or after sunset unless authorized on this permit.
8. Permit not valid on roads not under the jurisdiction of the Richland County Highway Department.
9. No movement of vehicles equipped with steel tires, cleats, blocks, studs, flanges or pikes.
10. Pilot cars are required for all movements exceeding 14'6" in width, 18' in height and 120' in overall length.
11. Check vertical clearance of all structures on route before starting movement. During spring breakup watch for highways heaving near structures. During winter watch for snow and ice buildup around structures.
12. If load exceeds 18' in height, mover must have written permission from utility companies to travel under overhead wires.

Additional Requirements for all Overweight Permits

1. No movement on flexible pavement with the atmospheric temperatures exceeds 90 degrees F.
2. Rate of speed shall not exceed 40 mph on bituminous (paved) surfaces. When crossing structures with overweight loads, rate of speed shall not exceed 15 mph.
3. Bridges must be crossed in the center lane at reduced speed, or as indicated on this permit.

Additional Requirements for Earthmoving Equipment

1. If more than one unit in convoy, keep at least 1000 feet apart so as not to hamper passing traffic.
2. After each two (2) hours of traveling, stop and cool tires for at least thirty (30) minutes.
3. Must have one pilot car follow the movement at a distance of 300 to 700 feet on all highways because of maximum speed limit of 20 mph.

Harvest 10% Weight Exception Permit Policy

1. Issued for movements of farm products from the field to the initial point of storage.
2. Dates of movement will be July 15 through December 1.
3. Must follow axle weight limitations.
4. Gross vehicle widths are determined by the number of axles and measurement between extreme axle centers.
5. On some sections of highways, it may be necessary to restrict axle weights due to bridge structures limitations.
6. The 10% extra weight cannot be used in conjunction with the NDDOT approved equipment policy. The 10% can be issued above legal weights only.
7. The registered gross weight does not have to include the additional 10%. The vehicle must be registered for the maximum legal gross vehicle weight.

Winter Weight 10% Weight Exception Permit Policy

1. Issued for movements of all products on county highways when road beds are frozen
2. Dates of movement will be December 1 through March 7.
3. Must follow axle weight limitations
4. Gross vehicle widths are determined by the number of axles and measurement between extreme axle centers.
5. On some sections of highways, it may be necessary to restrict axle weights due to bridge structures limitations.
6. The 10% extra weight cannot be used in conjunction with the NDDOT approved equipment policy. The 10% can be issued above legal weights only.
7. The registered gross weight does not have to include the additional 10%. The vehicle must be registered for the maximum legal gross vehicle weight.
